A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW INSURERS TO LIMIT OR EXCLUDE EXCESS LIABILITY
COVERAGE FOR UNINSURED AND UNDERINSURED MOTORISTS AS
PROVIDED BY LAW.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 3 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by
adding a new section to read:

**"§ 58-3-152. Excess liability policies; uninsured and underinsured motorist
coverages.**

With respect to policy forms that provide excess liability coverage, an insurer may
limit or exclude coverage for uninsured motorists as provided in G.S. 20-279.21(b)(3)
and for underinsured motorists as provided in G.S. 20-279.21(b)(4)."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
