Short Title: Restore Suspended Benefits.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO INCREASE RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR MEMBERS OF THE
2 CONSOLIDATED JUDICIAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM WHOSE BENEFITS
3 WERE SUSPENDED AS A RESULT OF REEMPLOYMENT.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 135-56A is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

7 "(d) Upon the reinstatement of benefits of any retired member of the Consolidated
8 Judicial Retirement System whose benefits were suspended upon that member's entry
9 into the Teachers' and State Employees' Retirement System, that member's years of
10 service under the applicable provision of G.S. 135-56 shall be increased by the number of
11 years that the member's benefits under the Consolidated Judicial Retirement System were
12 suspended."

13 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
