A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS, LAND ACQUISITION, AND AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH AT NORTH CAROLINA AGRICULTURAL AND TECHNICAL STATE UNIVERSITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for the completion of the Dudley Building on the campus of North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of six million three hundred thousand dollars (\$6,300,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to be used by North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University for land acquisition.

Section 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year as matching funds for agricultural research and

1 extension programs at North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University. These
2 funds are in addition to any State funds appropriated for these programs and shall be
3 allocated as follows:

- 4 (1) \$500,000 to match federal funds for the Agricultural Research Program.
5 (2) \$500,000 to match federal funds for the Cooperative Extension
6 Program.

7 Section 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
