A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO REIMBURSE A HOST LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT FOR LOCAL FUNDS SPENT FOR THE EDUCATION OF A STUDENT WHO IS RESIDING IN A GROUP OR THERAPEUTIC HOME.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of three million five hundred ninety-five thousand two hundred seventy-five dollars (\$3,595,275) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for a reserve for severely disabled children in group or therapeutic homes. These funds shall be used to reimburse the local school administrative unit in which the group or therapeutic home is located for the special education of children whose parents reside outside of that local school administrative unit.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
