A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE TOWN OF SALEMBURG FOR
RENOVATION AND RESTORATION PROJECTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of
Salemburg the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for
renovation and restoration of buildings of historic character within the Town of
Salemburg.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
