A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE RENOVATION OF A BUILDING
AT ASHEVILLE-BUNCOMBE TECHNICAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Community Colleges the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for the renovation of the historic Fernihurst home on property owned by Asheville-Buncombe Technical Community College. The Fernihurst facility shall house the college's second-year culinary program.

The Fernihurst facility will be open to the public on a limited basis to broaden students' training experience and will provide a classical dining atmosphere for culinary, hospitality, and tourism training to better prepare students for a professional career in the culinary arts or hospitality management.

Section 2. These funds shall be matched on the basis of one dollar (\$1.00) in non-State funds for every two dollars (\$2.00) in State funds.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
