A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES COMMISSION TO ALL OF JONES, WILMINGTON, AND SALISBURY STREETS PROXIMATE TO THE STATE LEGISLATIVE BUILDING, AND TO THE BRICK WALKWAY PROXIMATE TO THE LEGISLATIVE OFFICE BUILDING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 120-32.1(d) reads as rewritten:

"(d) For the purposes of this section, the term "State legislative buildings and grounds" means:

(1) At all times:

a. The State Legislative Building;

a1. ~~The areas between the outer walls of the State Legislative Building and the near curblin~~ of those sections of Jones, Wilmington, and Salisbury Streets which border land on which it is situated;

a2. The ~~area~~ areas between the outer walls of the State Legislative Building and the far curblin of those sections of Jones,

- 1 Wilmington, Salisbury, and Lane Streets that border that section
2 of Lane Street which borders the land on which it is situated;
3 b. The Legislative Office Building—Building, its garden area and
4 outer stairway, and the areas between its outer walls and the near
5 curbline of those sections of Lane and Salisbury Streets that
6 border the land on which it is situated;
7 c. Any State-owned parking lot which is leased to the General
8 Assembly; and
9 d. The bridge between the State Legislative Building and the State
10 Governmental Mall—Mall; and
11 e. A portion of the brick sidewalk surface area of the State
12 Government Mall, described as follows: beginning at the
13 northeast corner of the Legislative Office Building, thence east
14 across the brick sidewalk to the inner edge of the sidewalk
15 adjacent to the grassy area of the Mall, thence south along the
16 inner edge of the sidewalk to the southwest outer corner of the
17 Mall water fountain, thence east along the southern outer edge of
18 the fountain to a point north of the northeast corner of the
19 pedestrian surface of the Lane Street pedestrian bridge, thence
20 south from that point to the northeast corner of the pedestrian
21 surface of the bridge, thence west along the southern edge of the
22 brick sidewalk area of the Mall to the southeast corner of the
23 Legislative Office Building, thence north along the east wall of
24 the Legislative Office Building, to the point of beginning.

28 a. ~~When the General Assembly is in regular or extra session; and~~

37 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
