A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO RESTORE EXTRATERRITORIAL PLANNING POWERS OF THE TOWN OF RIVER BEND BUT PROHIBIT IT FROM MAKING INVOLUNTARY ANNEXATIONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section VI of the Charter of the Town of River Bend, being that Charter approved by the Municipal Board of Control and filed with the Secretary of State on January 14, 1981, as added by Chapter 26 of the Session Laws of 1987, reads as rewritten:

"Section VI. The Town may not exercise in Craven County any ~~extraterritorial jurisdiction or extraterritorial~~ powers under Parts 2 and 3 of Article 19-4A of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes. Nothing in this section shall affect in any way the authority of the Town to annex property in Craven County by petition under Parts 1 and 4 of Article 4A of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes, entitled, respectively, 'Extension by Petition' and 'Annexation of Noncontiguous Areas'."

Section 2. This act becomes effective 30 days after it becomes law.
