A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF SHALLOTTE TO
2 AUTHORIZE THE TOWN TO ENFORCE ORDINANCES AS PROVIDED IN THE
3 GENERAL LAW.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Section 9 of the Charter of Shallotte, being Chapter 339 of the
7 Public Laws of 1899, reads as rewritten:

8 "Sec. 9. Violations.

9 ~~Any person violating any ordinance of said town shall be deemed guilty of a~~
10 ~~misdemeanor, but the punishment thereof upon conviction shall not exceed a fine of \$50~~
11 ~~or imprisonment for 30 days. The provisions of G.S. 160A-175 govern violations and~~
12 ~~enforcement of ordinances adopted by the Board of Aldermen."~~

13 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
