A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT INFORMATION IN THE STOKES COUNTY 911  
2 DATABASE OBTAINED FROM A TELEPHONE COMPANY IS  
3 CONFIDENTIAL IF REQUIRED BY THE AGREEMENT OBTAINING THE  
4 INFORMATION.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. Automatic number identification and automatic location  
8 identification information that consists of the name, address, and telephone numbers of  
9 telephone subscribers which is contained in a county 911 database is confidential and is  
10 not a public record as defined by Chapter 132 of the General Statutes if that information  
11 is required to be confidential by the agreement with the telephone company by which the  
12 information was obtained. Dissemination of the information contained in the 911  
13 automatic number and automatic location database is prohibited except on a call-by-call  
14 basis only for the purpose of handling emergency calls or for training, and any permanent  
15 record of the information shall be secured by the public safety answering points and  
16 disposed of in a manner which will retain that security except as otherwise required by  
17 applicable law.

18 Section 2. This act applies to Stokes County only.

19 Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
