A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL RESOURCES FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE SANFORD HOUSE IN LAURINBURG.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of one hundred twelve thousand dollars (\$112,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for the Restoration of the Betsy Sanford House in Laurinburg. The house, which was built in the late 1870s, was the boyhood home of Terry Sanford. The house is currently owned by the Scotland County Literacy Council, which will use the site for office space and to provide tutoring services.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
