A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO ISSUE TICKETS FOR
OVERTIME PARKING ON CITY STREETS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter VI, Subchapter A, Article 1 of the Charter of the City of
Charlotte, being Chapter 713 of the 1965 Session Laws, is amended by adding a new
section:

"Section 6.25. **Overtime Parking.** The City Council may adopt ordinances which
provide that each hour a vehicle remains illegally parked in an on-street parking space is
a separate offense and the violator may be given a ticket for each offense."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
