**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FARMERS  
MARKET IN THE TOWN OF AYDEN.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Ayden in Pitt County the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year for the construction of a facility to be used as a farmers market and a place for school and recreational activities by the Town's elementary school when the facility is not being used as a farmers market. This appropriation matches the fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) the Perkins Foundation contributed for this project.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
