A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC  
INSTRUCTION TO ENABLE THE CUED SPEECH CENTER TO PROVIDE  
SERVICES TO HEARING IMPAIRED CHILDREN.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of one hundred eighty-five thousand dollars (\$185,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to be allocated to the Cued Speech Center in Wake County to enable the continuation of needed services to hearing impaired children. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

(1)	Preschool services	\$90,000	
(2)	Transitional and resource services		<u>95,000</u>
	TOTAL	\$185,000.	

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
