A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION OF THE CITY OF
CHARLOTTE TO SET CERTAIN SPEED LIMITS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Charter of the City of Charlotte, being Chapter 713 of the 1965
Session Laws, is amended by adding the following new section to Article 1 of Subchapter
A of Article VI:

"Section 6.26. **Speed Limits.** The Director of Transportation may establish speed
limits, as required by G.S. 20-141, on streets within the City of Charlotte, on behalf of the
local governing body, the Charlotte City Council."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
