SENATE BILL 680

Short Title: Polymers Extension Program Funds.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL EXPENDITURES FOR THE
EXPANSION OF THE POLYMERS EXTENSION PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce the sum of one million four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,450,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to provide sufficient additional space to accommodate the expanded programs of and demands on the Polymers Extension Program, in order to support and encourage further development of polymers processing and production and related industries in North Carolina. These funds shall be used solely for the following:

- (1) Construction of a new building
for the Polymers Extension Program. \$1,400,000
 - (2) Relocation of equipment for the
Polymers Extension Program from the
the existing location to the new
building. 50,000
- TOTAL \$1,450,000.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
