A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA FOR NORTH CAROLINA
AGRICULTURAL AND TECHNICAL STATE UNIVERSITY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year for ongoing State support of agricultural research and extension programs at North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of six million dollars (\$6,000,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to be used by North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University for land acquisition.

Section 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year to be used by North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University as planning funds pertaining to the renovation of the Hines Hall science classroom building.

Section 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
