A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE
CONTROL PERMITS IN INTERSTATE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ZONES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 18B-1006 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(1) Interstate Interchange Economic Development Zones. – The Commission may issue permits listed in G.S. 18B-1001(10), without approval at an election, to qualified establishments defined in G.S. 18B-1000(4), (6), and (8) located within one and one-half miles of an interstate highway interchange located in a county that:

(1) Has approved the sale of malt beverages, unfortified wine, and fortified wine, but not mixed beverages;

(2) Operates ABC stores;

(3) Borders on another state; and

(4) Lies north of the Roanoke River."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
