**EFFECTIVE DATE:** "...when it becomes law..."

**BILL SUMMARY:** *TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO ADOPT ORDINANCES RELATING TO THE PARKING OR STANDING OF MOTOR VEHICLES NEAR FIRE HYDRANTS AND FIRE STATIONS AND IN FIRE LANES.* Amends charter of City of Charlotte as title indicates.<sup>1</sup>

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:** Bill language is permissive, not mandatory. If city council were to enact ordinances as authorized, it is assumed additional analysis would determine any increases in annual operating or capital (signs) expenditures associated with the implementation of the ordinance, and if determined necessary be duly appropriated into the annual budget.
