1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO GRANT AN ALLOWANCE FOR CONTROLLED HUNTING
3 PRESERVES LICENSED BY THE WILDLIFE RESOURCES COMMISSION
4 FOR THE TAKING OF DOMESTICALLY RAISED GAME BIRDS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. G.S. 103-2 reads as rewritten:

7 "§ 103-2. **Hunting on Sunday.**

8 If any person shall, except in defense of his own property, hunt on Sunday, having
9 with him a shotgun, rifle, or pistol, he shall be guilty of a Class 3 misdemeanor.
10 Provided, that the provisions hereof shall not be applicable to military reservations, the
11 jurisdiction of which is exclusively in the federal government, ~~or~~ to field trials
12 authorized by the Wildlife Resources ~~Commission~~ Commission, or to controlled
13 hunting preserves licensed by the Wildlife Resources Commission pursuant to G.S. 113-
14 273(g) for the taking of domestically raised game birds other than wild turkeys. Wildlife
15 protectors are granted authority to enforce the provisions of this section."

16 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2001.
