A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR UNIFORM PROVIDER CREDENTIALING BY
HEALTH INSURANCE PLANS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

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**SECTION 1.** Article 3 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by adding the following new section to read:

## "§ 58-3-230. Uniform provider credentialing.

- (a) An insurer that provides a health benefit plan shall maintain a process to assess and verify the qualifications of a licensed health care practitioner, or applicant for licensure as a health care practitioner, within 60 days of receipt of a completed provider application form approved by the Commissioner.
- (b) The Commissioner shall by rule adopt a uniform provider credentialing application form that will provide credentialing entities with the information necessary to adequately assess and verify the qualifications of an applicant. No insurer that provides a health benefit plan may require an applicant to submit information that is not required by the uniform provider credentialing application form.
- (c) As used in this section the terms 'health benefit plan' and 'insurer' shall have the meaning provided under G.S. 58-3-167.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2001.
