Short Title: Pharmacists/Limit Prescriptions Dispensed. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO LIMIT THE NUMBER OF PRESCRIPTIONS THAT MAY BE
DISPENSED WITHIN A DAY BY A PHARMACIST LICENSED IN THIS
STATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 4A of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended
by adding a new section to read:

"§ 90-85.32A. Limit number of prescriptions dispensed.

A pharmacist licensed pursuant to this Article shall not dispense more than 150
prescription drugs during the pharmacist's work shift within a single day."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
