HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 1262

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES
2 COMMISSION TO REVIEW THE SECURITY SURVEY OF THE GENERAL
3 ASSEMBLY COMPLEX AS ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES SECRET
4 SERVICE, AND IMPLEMENT ITS RECOMMENDATIONS AS NECESSARY.

5 Whereas, the United States Secret Service conducted a security survey of the
6 General Assembly Complex between September 18, 2000, and September 20, 2000; and

7 Whereas, a draft report of recommendations was received by the General
8 Assembly on April 11, 2001; and

9 Whereas, the United States Secret Service has made 149 recommendations in
10 its survey report; and

11 Whereas, the Secret Service has noted that "A variety of recommendations
12 are offered, some requiring additional personnel, others requiring immediate
13 implementation, and yet others requiring budgeting for future completion"; Now,
14 therefore,

15 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

16 **SECTION 1.** The Legislative Services Commission is directed to examine
17 the Security Survey of the North Carolina General Assembly Complex, conducted by
18 the United States Secret Service, and implement or make recommendations on
19 implementing its recommendations.

20 **SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective upon ratification.
