

1 this State and to discharge faithfully the duties of his office, and a record of each such
2 oath shall be filed with the secretary of the authority.

3 (c1) The authority shall select one of its members as chairman and another as
4 vice-chairman and shall also select a secretary and a treasurer who may but need not be
5 members of the authority. The offices of secretary and treasurer may be combined. The
6 terms of office of the chairman, vice-chairman, secretary and treasurer shall be as
7 provided in the bylaws of the authority.

8 (c2) A majority of the members of the authority shall constitute a quorum and the
9 affirmative vote of a majority of all of the members of the authority shall be necessary
10 for any action taken by the authority. No vacancy in the membership of the authority
11 shall impair the right of a quorum to exercise all the rights and perform all of the duties
12 of the authority. The members of the authority may be paid a per diem compensation set
13 by the authority which per diem may not exceed the total amount of ~~two~~ four thousand
14 dollars ~~(\$2,000)~~ (\$4,000) annually, and shall be reimbursed for the amount of actual
15 expenses incurred by them in the performance of their duties."

16 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law. For each water and
17 sewer authority organized under Article 1 of Chapter 162A of the General Statutes,
18 Section 2 of this act applies on the first day of the fiscal year of the authority that begins
19 on or after the date this act becomes effective.
