1 A JOINT RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE PRESIDENT IN HIS
2 EFFORTS TO FIND AND PUNISH THE TERRORISTS RESPONSIBLE FOR
3 THE DESTRUCTION OF THE WORLD TRADE CENTER, THE CRASHING OF
4 ONE PLANE INTO THE PENTAGON AND THE CRASHING OF ANOTHER
5 PLANE NEAR PITTSBURGH, PENNSYLVANIA, AND HONORING ALL
6 AMERICANS WHO HAVE LOST THEIR LIVES DUE TO THIS TRAGEDY.

7 Whereas, North Carolina takes great pride in the military and intelligence
8 personnel across the country; and

9 Whereas, an untold number of American civilians, military, and public safety
10 personnel have lost their lives; and

11 Whereas, this tragedy will affect not only the victims but also their families
12 and everyone else in the nation; and

13 Whereas, the intent of those terrorists was to disrupt our country and create
14 chaos; and

15 Whereas, the General Assembly pledges to support the President in his efforts
16 to find and punish the responsible parties; and

17 Whereas, the General Assembly is saddened by the loss of the World Trade
18 Center employees, the Pentagon employees, the passengers and crews on the four
19 airplanes, and the law enforcement officers and firemen who unwittingly gave their
20 lives; Now, therefore,

21 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

1 **SECTION 1.** The General Assembly of North Carolina wishes to express its
2 support for the President of the United States in all of his efforts to restore and protect
3 the American way of life.

4 **SECTION 2.** The General Assembly of North Carolina wishes to honor the
5 life and memory of those who lost their lives in this tragedy.

6 **SECTION 3.** The Secretary of State shall transmit a certified copy of this
7 resolution to the President of the United States.

8 **SECTION 4.** This resolution is effective upon ratification.
