A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT ALLOWING THE TOWN OF BETHEL TO EXTEND ITS  
3 EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OVER AN AREA EXTENDING TWO  
4 MILES BEYOND ITS LIMITS SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE PITT  
5 COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7       **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding G.S. 160A-360, the Town of Bethel may  
8 exercise the extraterritorial jurisdiction powers granted by Article 19 of Chapter 160A  
9 of the General Statutes within a defined area extending not more than two miles beyond  
10 the corporate limits, provided that the Pitt County Board of Commissioners shall have  
11 final approval authority of any extraterritorial jurisdiction beyond one mile.

12       **SECTION 2.** This act applies to the Town of Bethel and to Pitt County only.

13       **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
