A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO CLARIFY RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CITY OF  
2 LINCOLNTON SEAT ON THE LINCOLN COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 3 of Chapter 876 of the 1973 Session Laws reads as  
6 rewritten:

7 "Sec. 3. The newly constituted and established Lincoln County Board of Education  
8 shall consist of seven members, and each of said members shall be residents and  
9 qualified voters of the townships according to the membership allocations hereinafter  
10 made to said townships as follows:

11 (1) North Brook Township, (2) that area of Howard's Creek Township, Township  
12 outside the city limits of Lincolnton, (3) that the area of Lincolnton Township presently  
13 outside the present city limits of Lincolnton, (4) that area of Lincolnton Township and  
14 Ironton Township presently inside the city limits of Lincolnton, (5) that area of Ironton  
15 Township, Township outside the city limits of Lincolnton, and (6) Catawba Springs  
16 Township shall each be entitled to one member on the Lincoln County Board of  
17 Education. For the purpose of this section, the city limits of the City of Lincolnton are  
18 as of the opening of candidate filing.

19 One member shall be elected from the county at large, without regard to township."

20 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
