

- 1 1. Was entitled to retired pay for nonregular service under
2 Chapter 1223 of Title 10 of the U.S. Code.
3 2. Would have been entitled to retired pay for nonregular
4 service under Chapter 1223 of Title 10 of the U.S. Code
5 but for the fact that the person was under 60 years of age.
6 3. Was eligible for interment in a national cemetery under
7 Title 38, U.S.C. § 2402.
8 b. Who is a legal resident of North Carolina:
9 ~~(1)~~1. At the time of death, or
10 ~~(2)~~2. For a period of at least 10 years, or
11 ~~(3)~~3. At the time he entered the Armed Forces of the United
12 States."

13 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 65-43.1(a) reads as rewritten:

14 "(a) The following persons are eligible for interment at a State veterans cemetery:

- 15 (1) A qualified ~~veteran;~~veteran.
16 (2) The spouse, widow, or widower of a qualified veteran, or a minor child
17 who is unmarried and dependent on the qualified veteran at the time of
18 his ~~death;~~ and death. For purposes of this subdivision, "minor child"
19 includes a child under 21 years of age or under 23 years of age if
20 pursuing a course of instruction at an approved educational institution.
21 (3) An unmarried adult child of a qualified veteran when the child became
22 permanently incapable of self-support because of a physical or mental
23 disability before attaining the age of 18 years."

24 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
