A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF TWO ADDITIONAL
PUBLIC MEMBERS OF THE INFORMATION RESOURCE MANAGEMENT
COMMISSION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 147-33.78(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Creation; Membership. – The Information Resource Management Commission is established and shall be located within the Office for organizational, budgetary, and administrative purposes. The Commission consists of the following members:

- (1) Four members of the Council of State, appointed by the Governor.
- (2) The Secretary of State.
- (3) The Secretary of Administration.
- (4) The State Budget Officer.
- (5) Two members of the Governor's cabinet, appointed by the Governor.
- (6) ~~One citizen~~ Two citizens of the State of North Carolina with a background in and familiarity with information systems or telecommunications, appointed by the General Assembly upon the recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate in accordance with G.S. 120-121.
- (7) ~~One citizen~~ Two citizens of the State of North Carolina with a background in and familiarity with information systems or telecommunications, appointed by the General Assembly upon the recommendation of the Speaker of the House of Representatives in accordance with G.S. 120-121.
- (8) The Chair of the Information Technology Management Advisory Council.

- 1 (9) The Chair of the Criminal Justice Information Network Governing
2 Board.
- 3 (10) The State Controller.
- 4 (11) The Director of the Administrative Office of the Courts or the
5 Director's designee.
- 6 (12) The President of The University of North Carolina or the President's
7 designee.
- 8 (13) The President of the Community Colleges System Office or the
9 President's designee.
- 10 (14) The Executive Director of the North Carolina League of Municipalities
11 or the Executive Director's designee, who shall be a nonvoting
12 member.
- 13 (15) The Executive Director of the North Carolina Association of County
14 Commissioners or the Executive Director's designee, who shall be a
15 nonvoting member.
- 16 (16) The State Chief Information Officer, who shall be a nonvoting
17 member.

18 Members of the Commission shall not be employed by or serve on the board of
19 directors or other corporate governing body of any information systems, computer
20 hardware, computer software, or telecommunications vendor of goods and services to
21 the State of North Carolina.

22 The initial appointed members of the Commission shall be the members appointed to
23 the Information Resource Management Commission who are serving unexpired terms as
24 of July 1, 2000, who shall serve for a period equal to the remainder of their current
25 terms on the Information Resource Management Commission. Upon the expiration of
26 the current terms of the appointed members, their successors shall be appointed for
27 four-year terms, commencing July 1. Members of the Governor's cabinet shall be
28 disqualified from completing a term of service on the Commission if they are no longer
29 cabinet members. Members of the Council of State shall be disqualified from
30 completing a term of service on the Commission if they are no longer members of the
31 Council of State.

32 Vacancies in the ~~two~~ four legislative appointments shall be filled as provided in G.S.
33 120-122.

34 The Commission chair shall be elected in the first meeting of each calendar year
35 from among the appointees of the Governor from the Council of State and shall serve a
36 term of one year. The State Chief Information Officer shall be secretary to the
37 Commission.

38 No member of the Information Resource Management Commission shall vote on an
39 action affecting solely his or her own State agency."

40 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
