A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL  
RESOURCES FOR A NEW BLACKBEARD HISTORICAL MUSEUM IN THE  
TOWN OF BATH.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
Department of Cultural Resources, Division of Archives and History, the sum of two  
hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year to be used by  
the Historic Bath Commission for planning and design of a new Blackbeard historical  
museum in the Town of Bath.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
