A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR SCHOOL TECHNOLOGY NEEDS. 3 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State 5 Board of Education the sum of thirty-one million four hundred ninety thousand dollars 6 (\$31,490,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of thirty-one million four 7 hundred eighty-eight thousand five hundred forty-four dollars (\$31,488,544) for the 8 9 2002-2003 fiscal year to be used as follows: \$1,244,619 for each fiscal year to provide a technology facilitator in 10 (1) each low-performing school. 11 \$28,743,925 for each fiscal year to provide a technology facilitator in 12 (2) all schools where students must take the computer skills proficiency 13 14 exam. 15 (3) \$1,501,456 for each fiscal year to provide on-line resource subscriptions for students, teachers, and parents. 16

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
