A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT GRANDPARENTS MAY ACT AS SUPERVISING DRIVERS FOR DRIVERS HOLDING LIMITED LEARNER'S PERMITS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-11(k) reads as rewritten:

"(k) Supervising Driver. – A supervising driver shall be a ~~parent~~parent, grandparent, or guardian of the permit holder or license holder or a responsible person approved by the parent or guardian or the Division. A supervising driver shall be a licensed driver who has been licensed for at least five years. At least one supervising driver shall sign the application for a permit or license."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
