The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. Article 4 of Chapter 1 of the General Statutes is	s amended by
adding a new section to read:	
"§ 1-44.3. Dedication of public right-of-way.	
Whenever a deed recites the existence of a street, based on a p	olat that was
unrecorded and where there was no ordinance requiring the plat to be reco	orded, and the
plat has been lost, but a copy of the portion of the plat has been found	showing that
there is a right-of-way, and where the road has in fact been open to the p	ublic, and the
owners of two-thirds of the lots abutting the section of road in question are	petitioners in
a special proceeding requesting that the right-of-way be declared to have b	een dedicated
as a public road right-of-way, the clerk of superior court may issue an or	
the section of right-of way to be dedicated to public use upon finding those	facts."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
