12         **SECTION 4.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
13 Administrative Office of the Courts the sum of three hundred thousand dollars  
14 (\$300,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year to implement the bill.

15         **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
