A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ERECT
2 MEMORIAL SIGNS ALONG HIGHWAYS FOR STATE HIGHWAY PATROL
3 MEMBERS AND OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL KILLED IN
4 THE LINE OF DUTY.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
8 new section to read:

9 "**§ 136-42.4. Officers' memorial signs.**

10 The Department shall erect signs along North Carolina's highways memorializing
11 members of the State Highway Patrol and other law enforcement personnel who have
12 died in the line of duty. The Department shall coordinate the placement and contents of
13 these memorial signs with the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety."

14 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
