1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ERECT
3 MEMORIAL SIGNS ALONG HIGHWAYS FOR STATE HIGHWAY PATROL
4 MEMBERS AND OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL KILLED IN
5 THE LINE OF DUTY.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
8 new section to read:

9 "**§ 136-42.4. Officers' memorial signs.**

10 The Department shall, upon request, erect signs along North Carolina's highways
11 memorializing members of the State Highway Patrol and other law enforcement
12 personnel who have died in the line of duty in a highway-related enforcement action.
13 The Department shall coordinate the placement and contents of these memorial signs
14 with the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety. The requesting family or
15 organization shall reimburse the Department for the cost of the memorial sign and its
16 installation."

17 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
