A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR COALITION 2001 PROGRAMS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE STUDY COMMISSION ON MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of one hundred one million five hundred fifty-three thousand dollars (\$101,553,000) for the 2001-2002 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred one million five hundred fifty-three thousand dollars (\$101,553,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated in each fiscal year as follows:

- (1) \$67,825,000 for the Community Services Department, as follows:
 - a. \$20,750,000 for Child Mental Health/Substance Abuse
 - b. \$18,149,000 for Adult Substance Abuse and Mental Health – DD waiting list
 - c. \$3,300,000 for Family Support – MH&DD
 - d. \$4,568,000 for Supported Employment
 - e. \$16,088,000 for Housing/Residential
 - f. \$4,970,000 for other special services and programs
- (2) \$2,500,000 for Ticket to Work – DMA
- (3) \$23,700,000 for Medicaid Waiver – CAP/DDMR
- (4) \$7,528,000 for Inflationary Jordan-Adams DMH/DD/SA and Division of Early Intervention

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
