1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PERMIT THE HIGHWAY USE OF OFF-ROAD VEHICLES USED IN
3 AGRICULTURAL QUARANTINE PROGRAMS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 20-51 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
6 "§ 20-51. Exempt from registration.

7 The following shall be exempt from the requirement of registration and certificate of
8 title:

9 ...

10 (14) Any vehicle that meets all of the following:

- 11 a. Is designed for use in work off the highway.
12 b. Is used for agricultural quarantine programs under the
13 supervision of the Department of Agriculture and Consumer
14 Services.
15 c. Is driven or moved on the highway for the purpose of going to
16 and from nonhighway projects.
17 d. Is identified in a manner approved by the Division of Motor
18 Vehicles.
19 e. Is operated by a person who possesses an identification card
20 issued by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer
21 Services."

22 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
