SENATE BILL 833

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO MAKE IT ILLEGAL TO POSSESS ANY FORM OF FALSE
3 IDENTIFICATION WHILE ATTEMPTING TO OBTAIN ALCOHOLIC
4 BEVERAGES WHEN UNDERAGE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. G.S. 18B-302(e) reads as rewritten:

7 "(e) Fraudulent Use of Identification. – It shall be unlawful for any person to enter
8 or attempt to enter a place where alcoholic beverages are sold or consumed, or to obtain
9 or attempt to obtain alcoholic beverages–beverages, or to obtain or attempt to obtain
10 permission to purchase alcoholic beverages, in violation of subsection (b) of this section
11 section, by using or attempting to use; use any of the following:

12 (1) A fraudulent or altered ~~driver's license; or~~ drivers license.

13 (2) A fraudulent or altered identification document other than a ~~driver's~~
14 license; or drivers license.

15 (3) A ~~driver's~~ drivers license issued to another ~~person; or~~ person.

16 (4) An identification document other than a ~~driver's~~ drivers license issued
17 to another person.

18 (5) Any other form or means of identification that indicates or symbolizes
19 that the person is not prohibited from purchasing or possessing
20 alcoholic beverages under this section."

21 SECTION 2. G. S. 18B-302(f) reads as rewritten:

22 "(f) Allowing Use of Identification. – It shall be unlawful for any person to permit
23 the use of ~~his–driver's~~ the person's drivers license or any other form of identification
24 document of any kind issued or given to the person by any other person who violates or
25 attempts to violate subsection (b) of this section."

26 SECTION 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 2001, and applies to
27 offenses committed on or after that date.
