SECTION 1. G.S. 18B-302(e) reads as rewritten:

or attempt to obtain alcoholic beverages beverages, or to obtain or attempt to obtain	
permission to purchase alcoholic beverages, in violation of subsection (b) of this section

SECTION 2. G. S. 18B-302(f) reads as rewritten:	
"(f) Allowing Use of Identification. – It shall be unlawful for any person to permit	
the use of his driver's the person's drivers license or any other form of identification	
document of any kind issued or given to the person by any other person who violates or	
attempts to violate subsection (b) of this section."	

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 2001, and applies to

offenses committed on or after that date.
