A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT RACE-SPECIFIC DATA REPORTING BE
ACCURATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. This act may be cited as the Accurate Race-Specific Data Act.

SECTION 2. As used in this act, "party" means a client, participant,
employer, contractor, vendor, or supplier.

SECTION 3. All departments of State and local government that capture
and maintain race-specific data by visual identification shall verify that information by
asking the party.

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
