**BILL SUMMARY:** Reauthorizes the study of commission contracts for the issuance of motor vehicle registration plates and certificates and provides an appropriation of \$25,000 from the Highway Fund for the 2001-2002 fiscal year for expenses of the Commission. Section 10 requires the Division of Motor Vehicles of DOT, in consultation and cooperation with the commission contract agents, to conduct a comprehensive and updated productivity study of all transactions and other activity in contract agencies.

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:** The \$25,000 appropriation from the Highway Fund is shown as expenditure above. The productivity study required in Section 10 is currently being conducted by DOT's Productivity Services section and DMV using existing resources.
