1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PERMANENT RULES OF THE 2003
2 EXTRA SESSION OF THE NORTH CAROLINA HOUSE OF
3 REPRESENTATIVES.

4 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

5 **SECTION 1.** The permanent rules of the 2003 Regular Session of the House
6 of Representatives, with the following amendments, are adopted as the permanent rules
7 of the 2003 Extra Session:

8 (1) RULE 1 shall read as follows: "RULE 1. **Convening Hour.** The
9 House shall convene each legislative day at the hour fixed by the
10 House. In the event the House adjourns on the preceding legislative
11 day without having fixed an hour for reconvening, the House shall
12 convene on the next legislative day at 10:00 A.M."

13 (2) Notwithstanding RULE 26, the Committee on Rules, Calendar, and
14 Operations of the House, the Ethics Committee, and the Legislative
15 Redistricting Committee shall be comprised of the members who were
16 appointed during the regular session and other members as the Speaker
17 may appoint at the beginning of the Extra Session. The Chairs and
18 Vice-Chairs of those committees shall be those who were appointed by
19 the Speaker during the Regular Session.

20 (3) Notwithstanding RULE 27, the standing committees and permanent
21 subcommittees of the House are:

27 All rules of the 2003 Regular Session applicable to standing
28 committees and permanent subcommittees of the House other than the

- 1 committees named in this subdivision are inoperative. The Speaker
2 may appoint select committees under RULE 26.
- 3 (4) Notwithstanding RULE 31(a), any bill or resolution shall be
4 introduced by submitting the bill or resolution to the Principal Clerk's
5 Office.
- 6 (5) Notwithstanding RULES 31 and 31.1:
- 7 a. The only resolutions that may be introduced or considered in
8 the House are resolutions adjourning the 2003 Extra Session
9 sine die.
- 10 b. All bills shall be excluded from introduction or consideration in
11 the House, other than bills regarding legislative redistricting and
12 matters pertaining or related thereto.
- 13 (6) RULE 31.1 shall not apply to resolutions adjourning the 2003 Extra
14 Session sine die and bills regarding legislative redistricting and matters
15 pertaining or related thereto.
- 16 (7) Notwithstanding RULES 32 and 41, a resolution or bill may be placed
17 on the calendar without being referred by the Speaker to a committee
18 and on the same legislative day of its introduction or receipt from the
19 Senate.
- 20 (8) Notwithstanding RULE 41:
- 21 a. The first reading and reference to a standing committee of a
22 House bill shall occur on the legislative day of its introduction.
23 The first reading and reference to a standing committee of a
24 Senate bill shall occur on the legislative day of its receipt on
25 messages from the Senate. The Speaker shall give notice at each
26 subsequent reading whether it is the second or third reading.
- 27 b. Except for a bill governed by Article II, Section 23 of the North
28 Carolina Constitution, a bill may be read more than once on the
29 same day.
- 30 (9) Notwithstanding RULE 44(d), a conference report may be placed on
31 the calendar for the legislative day on which the report is received.
- 32 (10) Notwithstanding RULE 59, any member wishing to cosponsor a bill or
33 resolution that has been introduced may do so by appearing in the
34 office of the Principal Clerk for that purpose on the day during which
35 the bill or resolution was first read and referred, but only while the bill
36 or resolution is in the possession of the House.

37 **SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
