1 A SENATE RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PERMANENT RULES OF THE
2 SENATE FOR THE 2003 EXTRA SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

3 Be it resolved by the Senate:

4 **SECTION 1.** The permanent rules of the 2003 Regular Session, with the
5 following amendments, are the rules governing the 2003 Extra Session of the General
6 Assembly:

7 **RULE 36. List of standing/select committees.** – The standing committees
8 shall be:

9 Redistricting.

10 Rules and Operations of the Senate.

11 All committees except Redistricting shall be comprised of the members who
12 were appointed to those committees during the 2003 Regular Session. Members of the
13 Redistricting Committee shall be appointed as provided in Rule 31.

14 **RULE 36.2. Amendments concerning redistricting.** – Any member of the
15 Senate may propose an amendment in committee on a bill, whether or not that Senator
16 is a member of the Committee. No amendment may be offered on the floor of the
17 Senate unless that amendment was proposed in committee. Any amendment changing
18 any districting plan must be accompanied by the analysis necessary to show compliance
19 with *Stephenson v. Bartlett*, in a manner announced by the chair of that committee.

20 **RULE 40. Introduction of bills.** – Every bill introduced shall contain on the
21 outside cover the title of the document and the name of the Senator or Senators
22 presenting it. The Principal Clerk of the Senate shall receive, number, and present each
23 bill to the Senate for first reading.

24 **RULE 40.1. Limitation on introduction and consideration of resolutions
25 and bills.** – The only resolutions that may be introduced or considered in the Senate are
26 resolutions adjourning the Extra Session sine die. The only bills, parts of bills, or
27 amendments to bills that may be introduced or considered in the Senate are bills, parts

1 of bills, or amendments adopting new redistricting plans for the North Carolina Senate
2 and the North Carolina House of Representatives and bills, parts of bills, or
3 amendments making changes to election laws or other laws related to or concerning the
4 review of legislative districts, and laws relating to presidentially declared natural
5 disasters.

6 RULE 41. (Reserved).

7 **RULE 43. First reading; reference to committee.** – All bills introduced and
8 all House bills received upon a message from the House of Representatives, upon
9 presentation to the Senate, shall be read in the regular order of business by their number
10 and title which shall constitute the first reading of the bill. The Chair of the Rules and
11 Operation of the Senate Committee or, in the Chair's absence, the Vice-Chair of the
12 Committee shall refer to a Senate committee all bills introduced in the Senate. Upon the
13 referral being made, the Chair of the Committee on Rules and Operation of the Senate
14 shall notify the Principal Clerk of the Senate of the referral, and the Reading Clerk shall
15 announce the referral of the bill. The Principal Clerk shall inform the Presiding Officer
16 of the referral. The title and referral shall be entered upon the Journal.

17 **RULE 43.1. Second reading.** – All bills reported by committee shall be
18 placed before the Senate for second reading and immediate consideration upon passage.

19 **RULE 50. Third reading requirements.** – When a bill or resolution has
20 passed its second reading, it shall be placed on the calendar for immediate consideration
21 on its third reading, unless prohibited by Article II, Section 23 of the Constitution.

22 **RULE 56.1. Amendments and committee substitutes adopted by the**
23 **House to bills originating in the Senate.** – (a) Whenever the House has adopted an
24 amendment or a committee substitute for a bill originating in the Senate and has
25 returned the bill to the Senate for concurrence in that amendment or committee
26 substitute, the Senate may concur in that amendment or committee substitute on the
27 same legislative day.

28 RULE 59. (Reserved).

29 **SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
