Short Title: Require Documentation-Certain Special Plates. (Public)

Sponsors: Representative Justus.

Referred to: Homeland Security, Military, and Veterans Affairs, if favorable, Transportation.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT CERTAIN SPECIAL PLATES THAT ARE AVAILABLE TO
3 MILITARY VETERANS ARE ISSUED ONLY TO APPROPRIATE APPLICANTS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-79.4 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

6 "(a1) Qualifying for a Special Plate. – In order to qualify for a special plate, an applicant
7 shall meet all of the qualifications set out in this section. The Division of Motor Vehicles shall
8 verify the qualifications of an individual to whom any special plate is issued to ensure only
9 qualified applicants receive the requested special plates. The Division shall not issue a special
10 plate that is based on military service unless the application is accompanied by a motor vehicle
11 registration (MVR) verification form signed by the Director of the Division of Veterans
12 Affairs, or the Director's designee, showing that the Division of Veterans Affairs has verified
13 the applicant's credentials and qualifications to hold the special plate applied for. Unless a
14 qualifying condition exists requiring annual verification, no additional verification shall be
15 required to renew a special registration plate either in person or through an online service. If the
16 Division of Veterans Affairs determines a special registration plate has been issued due to an
17 error on the part of the Division of Motor Vehicles, the plate shall be recalled and canceled. If
18 the Division of Veterans Affairs determines a special registration plate has been issued to an
19 applicant who falsified documents or has fraudulently applied for the special registration plate,
20 the Division of Motor Vehicles shall revoke the special plate and take appropriate enforcement
21 action.

22 The Division of Veterans Affairs shall be responsible for verifying and maintaining all
23 verification documentation for the following plates:

- 24 (1) Bronze Star Combat Recipient.
- 25 (2) Bronze Star Recipient.
- 26 (3) Combat Infantry Badge Recipient.
- 27 (4) Combat Veteran.
- 28 (5) Disabled Veteran.
- 29 (6) Distinguished Flying Cross.
- 30 (7) Gold Star Lapel Button.
- 31 (8) Legion of Valor.
- 32 (9) Military Wartime Veteran.
- 33 (10) Partially Disabled Veteran.
- 34 (11) Prisoner of War.
- 35 (12) Purple Heart Recipient.
- 36 (13) Silver Star Recipient."

37 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.



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
