A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PLACE SIGNS
ON BRIDGES IN LOCATIONS THAT ARE EASILY VIEWABLE FROM THE
WATERWAY OR HIGHWAY PASSING UNDER THE BRIDGES THAT PROVIDE
THE NAME OR ROUTE NUMBER OF THE HIGHWAY CROSSING OVER THE
BRIDGE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
section to read:

"§ 136-32.4. Signage on bridges.

The Department shall place signs on bridges, in locations that are easily viewable from the
waterway or highway passing under the bridges, that provide the name or route number of the
highway crossing over the bridge."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2009.
