	ECTION 1. G.S. 105-164.13 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
"§ 105-164.1	3. Retail sales and use tax.
The sale at retail and the use, storage, or consumption in this State of the following tangible	

(60) Liquefied petroleum gas when sold to an individual purchaser for domestic consumption. Domestic consumption does not include use or consumption for business, commercial, or industrial purposes."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2009, and applies to deliveries made on or after that date.
