A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE PLACEMENT OF SPEED TABLES OR TRAFFIC SPEED
CONTROL DEVICES ON THOSE PORTIONS OF STATE ROADS WITHIN A
RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 7 of Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by
adding a new section to read:

"§ 136-102.8. Subdivision streets; traffic calming devices.

The Department shall not prohibit the installation or utilization of traffic tables or traffic
calming devices erected on State-maintained subdivision streets adopted by the Department,
pursuant to G.S. 136-102.6, so long as the installation and utilization is within the subdivision
and the traffic tables or traffic calming devices are paid for and maintained by a homeowner's
association."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2009, and applies to traffic
calming devices or traffic tables installed on or after that date.
