

	PARENTI CURRICU COMMIS The General A	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED TO REQUIRE THE INCLUSION OF PERSONAL FINANCE AND HOOD TRAINING IN NORTH CAROLINA'S MIDDLE-SCHOOL JLUM, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE STUDY SION ON POVERTY REDUCTION AND ECONOMIC RECOVERY. Assembly of North Carolina enacts: CCTION 1. G.S. 115C-81(e1)(1) reads as rewritten: A comprehensive school health education program shall be developed an taught to pupils of the public schools of this State from kindergarten throug ninth grade. This program includes age-appropriate instruction in the following subject areas, regardless of whether this instruction is describe as, or incorporated into a description of, "family life education", "family health education", "health education", "family living", "health", "healthfuliving curriculum", or "self-esteem": a. Mental and emotional health; b. Drug and alcohol abuse prevention; c. Nutrition; d. Dental health; e. Environmental health; f. Family living; living, which in the middle schools shall including training for parenthood, both fathers and mothers; g. Consumer health; health; which in the middle schools shall including in personal finance. h. Disease control;
		 i. Growth and development; j. First aid and emergency care, including the teaching of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and the Heimlich maneuver b
		using hands-on training with mannequins so that students become proficient in order to pass a test approved by the American Heat Association, or American Red Cross;
		k. Preventing sexually transmitted diseases, including HIV/AIDS, an other communicable diseases;
		l. Reproductive health and safety education; and



As used in this subsection, "HIV/AIDS" means Human Immunodeficiency

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1	SECTION 2. The Department of Public Instruction and the Department of Health
2	and Human Services shall cooperate in the development of curricula to implement Section 1 of
3	this act.
4	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law. Section 1 of this act shall
5	be implemented by the beginning of the 2012-2013 school year.
