A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA FREEDOM  
MONUMENT AND TO MODIFY THE TERMS OF THE 2007-2008 GRANT-IN-AID.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year to be allocated to North Carolina Freedom Monument Project, Inc., for planning and development of the preconstruction stages of the monument, which will commemorate the African-American experience in the State.

**SECTION 2.** Funds appropriated by the 2007 General Assembly as a grant-in-aid for North Carolina Freedom Monument Project, Inc., to fabricate and construct a monument that have not been used for this purpose may be used by North Carolina Freedom Monument Project, Inc., for planning and development of preconstruction stages of the monument.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2010.
